New guidance has been issued from the Archbishops and endorsed by our Bishop. In summary, with immediate effect we are all urged:

i. To suspend for the time being the use of a shared chalice ('the common cup') at celebrations of Holy Communion, so that communicants receive only the consecrated bread. (Many of you will know that the doctrine of the Church of England teaches that the full spiritual benefit of the sacrament is received in 'one kind' — no-one ever misses out if they receive only the bread but not the wine at the Eucharist, or only the wine but not the bread.)

ii. To refrain for the time being from the laying on of hands in blessing at the communion rail for those not receiving the bread and wine (or for those receiving, for example, prayers for healing during worship or at other times).

iii. To refrain for the time being from the holy kiss or a handshake at the sharing of The Peace (and indeed when we greet fellow worshippers at the start of a service or bid them farewell at the end). Many of you have already begun to experiment creatively with alternatives, e.g. using sign language.

We will therefore be operating in this way from this Sunday 15th March.
